**'ALL ABOARD! TRAINS ON FILM SERIES'** (Friday) Freight trains once rolled along the High Line and now a train will once again make an appearance with an open-air screening at 7 p.m. of Alfred Hitchcock's 1951 film "Strangers on a Train" at the 14th Street passage.
